

Sunday Resources for September 27

Lesson: A Little Girl and a Poor Frail Lady from the Jesus Storybook Bible, pages, 214-221 The story of Jairus' daughter, from Luke 8

Aim: To understand that Jesus has power over sickness and death.

Questions:

- What happened to the little girl? She couldn't get out of bed one morning and no one knew how to make her better.
- Who was Jairus and what did he do? *He was the little girl's father. He loved her very much. He fought his way to see Jesus.*
- What did he ask Jesus? *He asked Jesus to heal his daughter.*
- What was Jesus' response? Jesus came right away. He knew it was an emergency so he went quickly.
- What happened in the middle of Jesus' important rescue mission? A sick woman touched Jesus' garment. Jesus felt her touch him and immediately stopped to help her.
- Why did the woman touch Jesus? She was very sick. She knew if she touched Jesus, she could be healed. She had great faith.
- What did Jesus' servants do? They said that Jesus didn't have time to stop. But Jesus cared about the woman and stopped to heal her, because of her great faith.
- What happened when Jesus arrived at the house of the little girl? *The people were upset. They told Jesus that it was too late to heal her. They were so sad.*
- Was it too late for Jesus? Nothing is too late for Jesus. Jesus told her to get up, and that's just what she did!

Review & Reflect: Jesus was able to make the poor lady better and bring Jairus back to life. Jesus can do things that we can't do. It's never too late for God. He has power over sickness and death.

Prayer: Dear Jesus, thank you! You are powerful and we can trust in you completely. Help me to have faith in you always. Help me to have faith like Jairus and the poor lady.
